I. What does prayerful obedience look like?

A. 4 steps in the process

1. The internal struggle
2. Asking God to change your circumstances
3. Accepting God’s plan for your circumstances
4. Seeking God’s glory in your circumstances

B. 3 Ways God’s glory was revealed through Jesus’ prayerful obedience

1. The cross revealed the false philosophies of this world
2. The cross freed us from the power/deception of the enemy
3. The cross draws people from every circumstance/background to be saved
